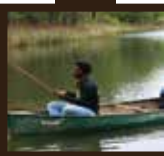

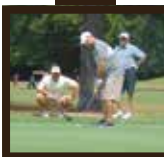

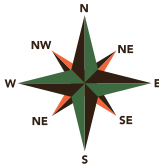

Calhoun County boasts an astounding array of outdoor recreational opportunities. From kayaking, horseback riding and fishing to mountain biking and hiking, Calhoun County can provide you with an ideal itinerary for an outdoor enthusiast!

Camp McClellan Horse Trails Campground

150 Mud Hole Rd., Anniston located off of Iron Mountain Rd. 256-954-1623

Camp McClellan is a 900-acre equestrian campground on the historic former Ft. McClellan Military Base with over 30 miles of well-marked trails.

***Camp Lee**

Camp Lee is a Retreat & Summer Camp located in Anniston, Alabama.

***Cheaha State Park**

19644 Hwy. 281, Delta, 256-488-5111

Cheaha State Park is the highest point of Alabama and the state's first State Park. With its hiking, mountain biking trails, and swimming options, the park has it all, including meeting/wedding venue space, lodging and camping accommodations.

Chief Ladiga Trail

Anniston/Weaver/Jacksonville/Piedmont

The Chief Ladiga Trail (CLT) currently runs 32.5 miles from the Alabama/Georgia line into the City of Anniston. As Alabama's first Rails to Trails project, this paved recreational trail follows the former Seaboard/CSX Railroad and connects to Georgia's 61.5 mile Silver Comet Trail, making it the longest paved pedestrian pathway in the United States by becoming an 105+/- mile paced trail.

Choccolocco Creek Archeological Complex

The Alabama Indigenous Mound Trail at Choccolocco Park informs visitors of the rich, indigenous cultures that populated Alabama for thousands of years.

Coldwater Mountain Bike Trail

Located on over 4,000 acres of Coldwater Mountain in Anniston, experience riding a first class IMBA Bronze level trail with 45 miles of singletrack trail, specifically built for mountain biking. Coldwater Mountain is one of the best trail systems in not just Alabama, but the entire Southeast! This world class trail offers both 1.5-mile beginner loops, for riders of any level, and a 10-mile Blue Loop for intermediate riders. For more information, visit www.neaba.net.

Combat Park

Henry Farm Mountain Bike & Running Trails

351 Henry Road, Jacksonville

Located on the mountain adjacent to the Henry Farm Baseball Fields and parking lot, these trails are great for beginners and experienced riders and runners, with rock features and gradual climbs. The four loop trails are also open to pedestrians. The park also contains the Kiwanis Walking Trail and multiple nature trails which are open to foot traffic only.

Indian Mountain ATV Park

Indian Mountain ATV Park stretches over 4,700 acres offering ATV and OHV trail riding, camping, fishing, and hiking.

Lake Yahou Park

The McClellan Development Authority recently opened an 8-acre freshwater lake which features a half-mile walking trail, scenic 17-mile multi-use trails, and rustic picnic areas with bench seating. Lake Yahou offers catch-and-release fishing with a \$5 MDA license.

Little River Canyon National Preserve

From waterfalls to canyon rims, the river and canyon systems are spectacular Appalachian Plateau landscapes any time of year. Jacksonville State University owned Cayon Center now hours are 10 AM - 4 PM Tuesday thru Saturday.

McClellan Multi-Use Trails

Located on the former Ft. McClellan army installation, McClellan Mountain Bike Trails consist of 10 miles of purpose built singletrack and is perfect for beginner riders of all ages. It is the first specifically designed NICA trail in the state of Alabama. The system has a great variety of green and blue trail segments.

Mountain Longleaf National Wildlife Refuge

Bains Gap Road, Anniston

With more than 6,000 acres, this area was designated as a National Wildlife Refuge to protect a unique and endangered ecosystem, the mountain longleaf pine forest. This land is also home to the Bain's Gap Waterfall and trails.

Neely Henry Lake

Ohatchee

This 11,000 acre lake is perfect for skiing, boating and fishing along Hwy 77 North. This area has public boat launches, picnic areas and fishing piers perfect for the whole family.

Oxford Lake, Freedom Park, & Liberty Park

401 McCullars Lane, Oxford, 256-831-2660

This area houses tennis courts, baseball complex, indoor basketball courts, an expanded civic center space, playground, splash pad, gravel track and more. It is also home to one of Alabama's oldest remaining covered bridges. Located at the south end of Oxford Civic Center, Liberty Park memorializes our veterans and first responders.

Pinhoti National Recreation Trail

Talladega/Cleburne/Calhoun Counties

This is Alabama's premiere long-distance recreation trail, spanning 110 miles through the state and traversing the ridges and crests of the Talladega National Forest Mountains continuing in Georgia for a total of 335 miles to connect with the Appalachian Trail.

Anniston Civil Rights Trail

The trail includes ten historic sites marked with brown and gold historic markers in the City of Anniston. Each marker includes information about the specific event that took place at each trail site.

*Anniston Museums & Gardens

800 Museum Drive, Anniston, 256-237-6766

Explore the wilds of Africa, the mysteries of 2,300 year-old Egyptian Mummies and more than 2,000 items in the Anniston Museum of Natural History. See Colonel Berman's incredible and fascinating collection of weapons and artifacts at the Berman Museum of World History. Take a walk around the grounds at Longleaf Botanical Gardens.

C.A.S.T. – Community Actors Studio Theater

This community theater performs a variety of shows each year, including plays, musicals and dramas. For more information, visit www.castalabama.com.

Centennial Memorial Park

225 E. 17th Street, Anniston

Since 1999, this site serves as the official home of Alabama's Veterans Memorial and State Law Enforcement Memorial. The names of every Alabamian killed during World War I, World War II, the Korean War, Vietnam, Persian Gulf, Afghanistan, Iraq, and officers and firefighters killed in the line of duty are engraved on the granite wall.

Freedom Riders National Monument

1031 Gurnee Avenue, Anniston

National Park Service opened this monument in January 2017. Visitors can view a bus mural at the site of the former Greyhound bus station. Interpretive panels as well as a solar audio post recap the events of 1961, depicting the history of Calhoun County during the Civil Rights movement.

German-Italian Memorial Cemetery

3541 Shipley Road, Anniston

This small cemetery at McClellan is a historic landmark containing the graves of prisoners of war who were interred at Fort McClellan during World War II. There are 26 German soldiers and 3 Italian soldiers buried here. When these

soldiers died, they were given the same rights as an American soldier, including proper headstones. Every November, military officers from Germany and Italy are invited to perform a wreath-laying service, which is open to the public. It is currently maintained by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

Hobson City Museum for the Study of African-American History and Culture

715 Martin Luther King Drive, Hobson City

Alabama's first incorporated Black municipality in Alabama and the second in the nation. Established in 1899, this museum features archives and artifacts from the era.

Janney Furnace Civil War & Native American Museum

145 Janney Road, Ohatchee, 256-892-5198

Built in 1863 & 1864 to produce pig iron during the Civil War, this site and surrounding park hosts the Reenactment of the Battle of Ten Islands each spring. Their Museum houses Native American artifacts and memorabilia from the Civil War.

Oxford Performing Arts Center

100 Choccolocco St., Oxford 256-241-3322

This performance and concert venue accommodates 1,130 seats in the middle of historic downtown Oxford. With additions to the former historic school and city hall facility, this venue now houses state-of-the-art lighting and sound, an orchestra pit, dressing rooms, and a proscenium stage with large wing space and storage.

***The Church of St. Michael & All Angels**

1000 W 18th Street, Anniston, 256-237-4011

St. Michael and All Angels Episcopal Church is an historic church, designed by the famous architect William Halsey Wood of Newark, NJ. This historic church is an outstanding example of Norman architecture completed in 1890. This site includes white Carrara marble altar, alabaster reredos, hand-carved angels and crosses,

magnificent stained-glass windows, 95-foot bell tower, and an organ with nearly 3000 pipes. It was added to the National Register of Historic Places on March 14, 1978.

Talladega Superspeedway and the International Motorsports Hall of Fame

Visit the fastest closed track in the world with records exceeding 200 miles per hour.



The museum showcases vehicles that have set world records, antique automobiles, and more.

The World's Largest Office Chair

625 Noble St., Anniston, 256-237-1641

The World's Largest Office Chair is a roadside attraction. This chair is over 33 feet tall, 19.5 feet wide, and weighs 20,000 pounds. It is made of ten tons of steel. Built in 1981 by the "Miller's Office Furniture" store to make the store stand out, it is a model of a chair made by The HON Company.

***Big Time Entertainment**

A family entertainment center consisting of over 70,000 square feet of indoor and outdoor attractions such as: multi-level electric go-kart track, 18 bowling lanes, arcade games, two story Laser Tag arena, multi-story children's soft play area, axe throwing booths, outdoor adventure golf course, grill and event center for parties and group rentals.



Piedmont Polar Plunge

Each January, Piedmont's new aquatics center hosts a Polar Plunge to benefit a local non-profit supporting area cancer patients.

Black Heritage Festival

Each February, the Anniston Museums and Gardens host the longest running Black Heritage Festival in the Southeast, featuring vendors and entertainment.

Melee at McClellan

This NICA event is open to the public, and will feature exciting and intense bike races on McClellan Mountain Bike Trails at Fort McClellan.

Calhoun County Fair

Each spring and fall enjoy amusement rides, petting zoo, games, food, and family entertainment. Proceeds support youth agriculture education programs in Calhoun County.

Noble Street Festival & Alabama Cycling Classic Sunny King Criterium

Each Spring, Anniston becomes a haven for

cyclists, featuring pro bike races, restaurants, music, art, and more!

Cheaha Challenge & Ladiga Cruise

The Cheaha Challenge includes a 24, 44, 62, 84, 100, 124 mile bike routes and is known as the toughest ride in the south, climbing Alabama's highest point twice.

Jax Fest

Every July, Jacksonville Parks and Recreation host this fun family event at the public safety center. Bring your friends and family as Jacksonville celebrates our Independence Day. This event consists of food trucks, vendors, live music, and amazing fireworks at the end of the night.

Freedom Festival

Each Fourth of July, Oxford Lake celebrates with fun and festivities for the whole family. Stick around for the annual fireworks display!

Piedmont Independence Day Celebration

Every July, the Piedmont Arts and Entertainment Committee host this festival of food and fun for all celebrated under the sun. This event consists of live music, a foam party, and a spectacular firework show at the end of the night.

Woodstock 5K

Each August, this annual event boasts a 5K qualifying race and a Kidstock 1 mile race, with more than 1,000 runners and walkers taking to the pavement.

Hobson City's Founder's Day Festival

Each August, this annual event features a 5K, breakfast and banquet.

Rubato International Piano Competition

Each August, Oxford Performing Arts Center hosts a professionally juried Classical & Jazz piano competition with competitors and judges from all over the world.

Spirit on Mountain Street

Weaver Heritage Day

Each September, the Spirit of Weaver hosts their Weaver Heritage Day and Music Festival at Elwell

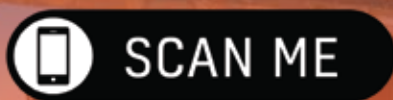
